

Digital Abstract Art

Create 3 distinctly different Abstract paintings

Digital Abstract Painting combines elements of traditional art making with digital technology. For this reason, it is sometimes given the name "tradigital art".

What distinguishes this form of digital abstract art from the other types is that digital abstract paintings are usually made from scratch, created using computer software to mimic the actions of painting, through using electronic brushstrokes in the application of "paint" or "ink" to the "canvas".

Composition: Create 3 paintings that utilize each of the three different compositional styles.

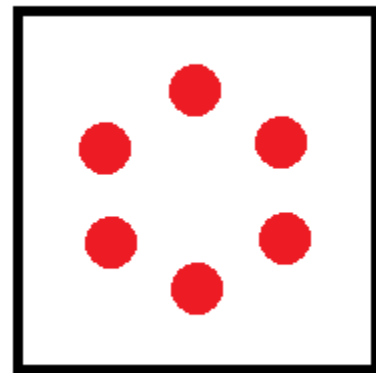
1) Balance

- Include the following Design principles within each painting.

2) Movement - Movement shows actions, or alternatively, the path the viewer's eye follows throughout an artwork. Movement is caused by using elements of art to give the feeling of motion and to guide the viewer's eyes throughout the artwork.

- 3) **Variety** - You create variety when elements are changed. Repeating a similar shape but changing the size can give variety and unity at the same time. Keeping the same size, but changing the color can also give variety and unity at the same time. In visual composition, there are many ways you can change something while simultaneously keeping it the same.
- 4) **Depth** - effects of depth, space, projection toward the viewer add interest. Linear perspective in the real world makes things look smaller in the distance.
