Illustrative Logo

A basic element of Graphic Design is being able to create *original content* with a purpose.

For this assignment, you will create a relatively simple logo design for a fictional client or company.

The **NAME** of the company and the **IMAGERY** that represents it should be married together in a creative and professional manner.

You are going to use a basic combination of descriptors for your logo NAME.

Noun + Verb or Adjective

10 Examples:

Net Speed Phone Glow
Game Blast Media Explosion
Zoo Tango Electric Hamster
Lightning Frog Beautiful War
Art Rampage Dark Vision

Here is your main challenge as a young person used to simply "borrowing" (stealing) existing imagery..... your work must be utterly unique and original.

- A key thing that you have learned thus far is how to take complex objects and "Simplify" them (eye, face, etc) It is totally fine to take an image from life and "Vectorize" it to create a new unseen version of it.
- This does not apply to copyrighted images (celebs, existing logos)


- Note: <u>Autotrace</u> will not work for this, as your logo should be relatively simple.
- Most graphic designers can draw. A great way to get started on this is to sketch or draw an idea, then scan it (me)






Or, you can create **simplified versions of more complex objects** by tracing and modifying the colors as needed.
