

## Independent Vector Bottle Drawing



### Objectives:

- Continue to learn the basics of constructing objects that exhibit definitive shape and form.
- Utilize various vector tools to create believable and professional illustrations
- Build upon the concepts of light, shadow, and transparencies in a drawing

### Process:

- 1) Choose one of the bottle styles listed in the lessons folder.
- 2) You may **NOT** trace or otherwise import the imagery into Corel draw.
- 3) Using the tools and processes learned through the two previous assignments, properly build the foundation of the bottle, and then add fountain fills, transparencies and details in the proper order.
- 4) Create a fully rendered and 3-dimensional bottle in vector format.
- 5) On your own, create a stylized label that includes:
  - a. Image that matches the wrapping color at the top
  - b. Appropriate text that matches in style and color with the label image
- 6) Save the file properly to the Inbox folder as a .CDR file
