
## Popular Culture Demotivational Poster





## **Basic Rules:**

- 1) This is a school appropriate assignment with school appropriate imagery and text. Period. If you can't make it funny or entertaining without resorting to "lowest common denominator" material then take the zero.
- 2) Leave out <u>racially</u> tinged ideas. It may be funny online, at your house, but you are doing a school project.
- 3) Leave out <u>suggestive</u> imagery and ideas. All imagery must be appropriate enough to be viewed by an administrator.
- 4) No curse words at all. None.
- 5) Dear manga dorks. Try not to use cartoons to illustrate real life.
- 6) Trying to circumvent these basic rules by being a general doofus.

## **Poster Setup**

- a) Image must be of adequate quality. Before you begin, look at the size and resolution of the image. (Image > Resample)
- b) Refer to the example below. The image should be <u>centered</u> on a field of <u>black</u>. There needs to be a white or light gray <u>border</u> around the image. Text appears as the <u>MAIN HEADLINE</u> with the <u>PUNCHLINE</u> located underneath. <u>Font</u> should match the mood of the idea.
