

CIRCUS FREAK DRAWING



Combine three (3) different animals together to form a new creature.

Objectives:

- Use your own creativity to create a new, **visually interesting** animal from the bodies and appendages of two others.
- Choose an animal **“base”** to use as the foundation for the rest of your drawing. This should be the main body that other parts are grafted onto.
- There should be at least one **“primary”** morphing element to the drawing. This means that there is a major change, such as a new head placed on to the body, four different legs placed onto the body, etc.
 - This rule is in place to ensure that no **“easy”** solutions are used, such as simply putting new wings and a new tail on your animal and turning it in.
- Place the new creature in some sort of environment that illustrates the size of the animal.
 - Sitting in your hand
 - Standing next to another animal
 - Flying next to a plane
 - In your house
 - At the zoo
 - In a circus

The following examples are computer generated images that are meant to simply give you an idea of what you are trying to accomplish. These images only use Two (2) combinations of animals, while you must add one more combination.
