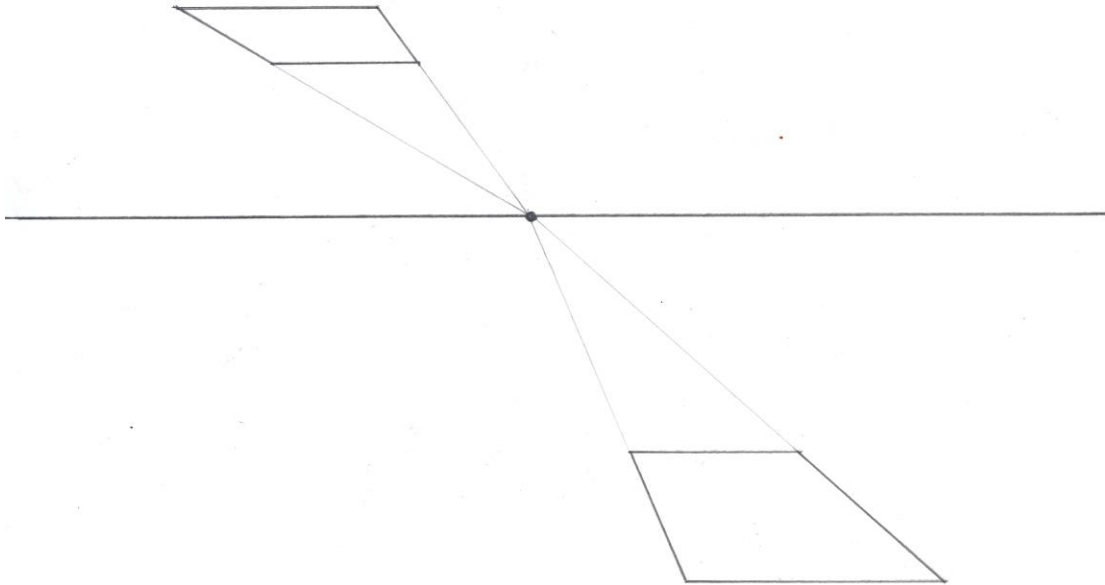


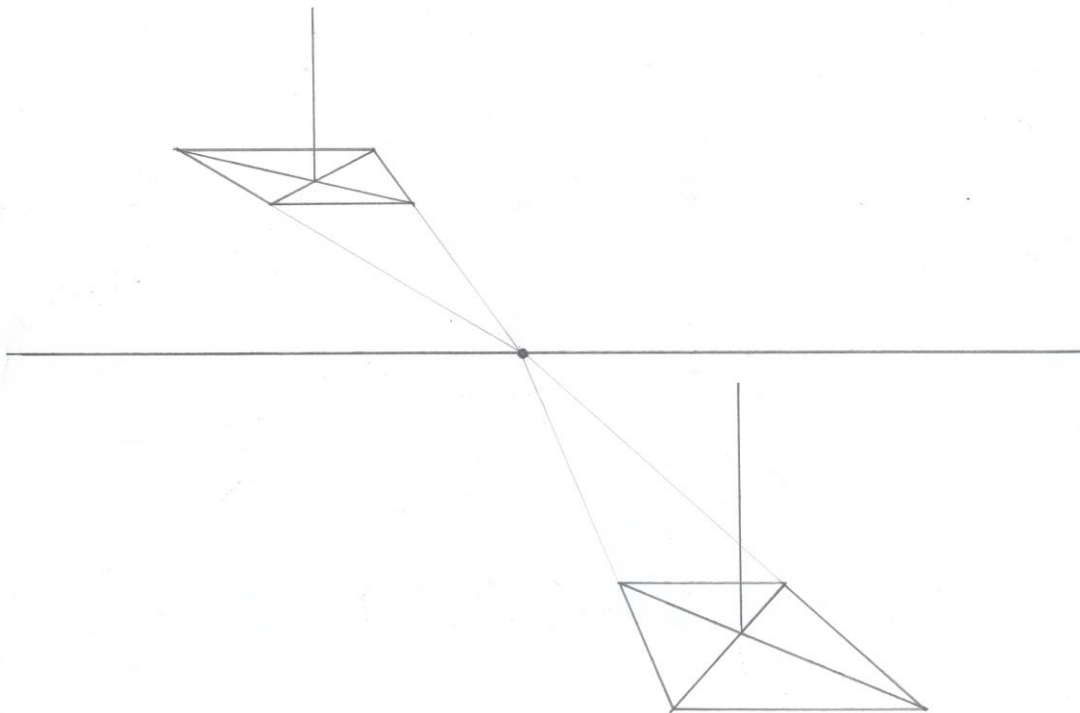
Draw a Pyramid in Perspective Pt 1

Follow the visual directions below in order to create two different pyramids, one above the horizon line, and one below. You can change how the pyramids look with simple erasing of the guidelines.

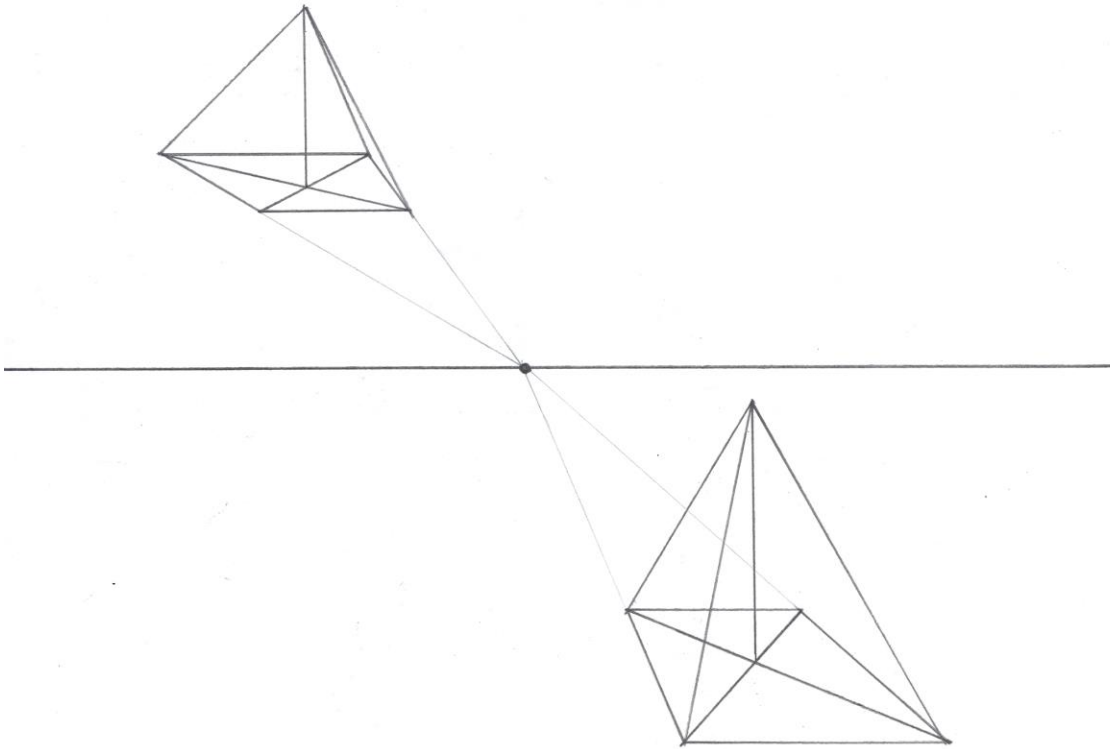
Step 1 – Create the bases of the pyramids



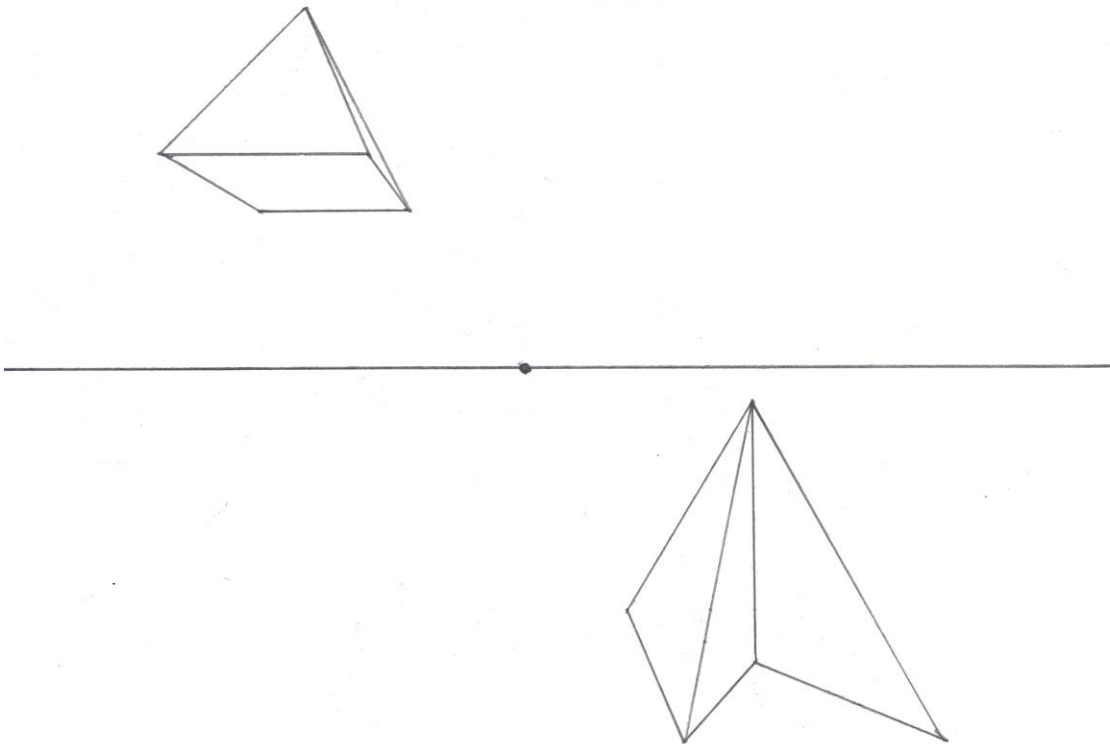
Step 2 – Find the midpoint of each base. Extend a line straight up from the center



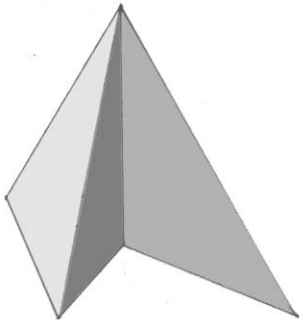
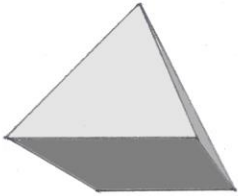
Step 3 – Draw connector lines from the top of the middle, to each corner



Step 4 – Erase the guidelines as shown. Make the top left pyramid a traditional shape. However, make the bottom right pyramid look different as shown.



Step 5 – Shade the sides similar to what is shown, to create the effect of three dimension.
