- 1) Use <u>Chrome</u> to find an image search engine such as Google Images
- 2) Click on "Search Tools" and then "Size". Choose "Large"

3) Browse images until you find something you want to print. Click on the thumbnail, and then choose "View Image" from the options.



4) Right click and choose "save image as..." browse to your personal student folder on the RCS network. Simply <u>look for your name</u> in the left hand column as shown...You may have to click on "Computer" first to see your name. Save here.
