

## Patriotic Art Guidelines

## 7 Main Rules

- 1) Imagery for all entries must be original. You may create work inspired by other photographers/artists imagery, but not to the degree that the new piece of artwork is easily recognized as being derivative of the other artist's work
- 2) The American flag has <u>13 stripes</u> and <u>fifty</u> small five pointed stars in the blue canton. This <u>must</u> be accurately represented, including stripes in correct order.
- 3) The flag should never appear to have something <u>standing</u> on it, <u>written</u> on it, or <u>lying</u> on it.
- 4) The flag should never be used as <u>wearing apparel</u>, <u>bedding</u>, or <u>drapery</u>
- 5) The flag should never be <u>used as receptable</u> for receiving, holding, carrying or delivering something.
- 6) The flag should never be <u>used as a covering</u> for a statue, vehicle, railcar, train, or boat. It should <u>always be displayed from a staff</u> in these situations.
- 7) The flag shall not be displayed from a float in a parade, unless it is <u>freely waving from a staff</u>.
