
Watercolor Pencil Fish Studies


Which method works best for you personally? Find out

- 1) Divide your paper in half. Sketch <u>two different fish</u> on each side of the paper using a pencil. Do not shade or add much detail.
- 2) Add a very light background wash around each fish. This is usually blue ⁽²⁾ and let it dry
- 3) Left side:
 - a. Use straight watercolor paint and add color to the fish. Be precise, edges crisp.
 - b. You must use at least three different colors, or blends of color for each fish
 - c. Work into the painting again with watercolor pencil. Dip the pencil into water first, and add markings, streaks in the fins, scales, etc. Again, be precise and show care.
- 4) Right Side:
 - a. Use watercolor pencil to color the entire fish.
 - b. You must use at least three colors, blending them when appropriate.
 - c. Add water only. Be careful not to use too much water, and use a smaller brush.
 - d. Work into the painting again with pencils, dipping them into water first. Add markings, streaks, scales, etc.
